

THE BLOODY CAESAR

The cocktail was invented at the Calgary Inn in Calgary in 1969. In its original form, it contained tomato juice, mashed clams, lime, vodka, and Worcestershire Sauce. It was called “The Calgary Eye Opener” and was served in a mug with a stylized picture of an “eye” on it. The restaurant at the Calgary Inn was wallpapered with old newspapers including one named “The Calgary Eye Opener” published by Bob Edwards in the early 1900’s. Story has it that Mr. Edwards frequented the long bar at the Alberta Hotel on Stephen’s Avenue and would order an “eye opener” on his way to work at the paper.

The opening of the Calgary Inn coincided with the release of Clamato by the American Mott’s company, and was not yet widely known or available, but soon became the mix of choice for the perfect Caesar.

The drink quickly became a favorite at the few downtown Calgary watering holes in the year that followed. With the opening of Julius Caesar’s Steakhouse in 1972 and a slight alteration in the recipe, we named it The Bloody Caesar and it found its true home.

A Mott’s Clamato Juice national advertising campaign in the mid 1980’s, featuring Caesar’s Steakhouse, recognized our role in popularizing this namesake cocktail.

Technically, any grape based spirit is a brandy. Cognac is a wine-based distillate from Cognac, France. In Italy the grape pomace is distilled after the wine making process is complete, the result is grappa. While a couple producers making “industrial” grappa account for 80% of production – and what many people think of when they think the worst of grappa - the remaining 20% is made by approximately 100 other small producers. The distillers below represent the elite in Italy, and their grappa, clear - or amber from barrel aging - are among the very best.
